

## WHAT HAPPENS WHEN YOU GET SAVED?

### I. YOU ARE MADE ALIVE UNTO GOD.

Eph. 2:1, “And you He made alive, who were dead in trespasses and sins.” (NKJV)

A. What does it mean when the Bible says we are dead? It means we are separated.

B. Holy Scripture speaks of three deaths:

1. Physical death: the separation of your spirit from your body.
2. Spiritual death: the separation of your spirit from God while you are still living on earth.
3. Eternal death: the separation of a person from God's presence forever.

Rev. 20:14-15, “Then Death and Hades were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death. And anyone not found written in the Book of Life was cast into the lake of fire.” (NKJV)

C. What does it mean when it says we were made alive?

1. It means you are given a new life - a new beginning, a new start. 2 Cor. 5:17
2. What does it mean to become a new creation?

II. YOU ARE ADOPTED INTO GOD=S FAMILY AS A CHILD-A SON OR A DAUGHTER.  
John 1:12

III. THE HOLY SPIRIT COMES TO LIVE IN YOUR LIFE.

John 14:16-18, “And I will pray the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may abide with you forever C the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees Him nor knows Him; but you know Him, for He dwells with you and will be in you. I will not leave you orphans;” (KJV)

A. When you receive Jesus Christ as your Savior and Lord, God sends the Holy Spirit to live within you. He is your Comforter and Helper.

B. Your body actually becomes the home of God's Spirit. 1 Cor. 6:19

C. As a true believer, your body actually becomes the Home of the Holy Spirit. The word body is singular; each believer is a home of the Spirit of God. Note three facts:

1. The Holy Spirit literally dwells within your body.
2. The Holy Spirit is a gift from God. Acts 2:38
3. God lays claim to your body. You no longer own your body. (1Cor 6:20) For God has bought you with a great price.

D. Once you receive Christ as your Savior and Lord, your body belongs to God and for this reason, we are to use our body to glorify God.

1 Cor. 6:20, “For God has bought you with a great price. So use every part of your body to give glory back to God because he owns it.” (TLB)

1. We are to use our body to glorify God by attending our church services.
2. We are to use our body to glorify God by living a holy life.
3. We are to use our body to glorify God by doing good works.

Titus 2:14, “Who gave Himself for us, that He might redeem us from every lawless deed and purify for Himself His own special people, zealous for good works.” (NKJV)
