Why Are They Here?



here are a lot of reasons why
I believe that the Bible is the
Word of God, but probably
the most remarkable one is
the existence of the Nation of Israel.
It stands as an enigma in history.
This kingdom was divided into two
nations, both taken over by foreign
powers and rebuilt under the Persian

Empire. It was then conquered by Greece, conquered by Rome, then destroyed and scattered in 70 AD. The Jewish people migrated across the known world, faced annihilation through the next 1800+ years by Muslims, Communists, and Nazis (among others) and yet reestablished themselves as a nation in 1948. For all practical purposes, no nation could survive such a long detachment from their homeland. So, why is Israel here?

The answer is in the Bible. Genesis 12:1-3 first introduces us to Abram (Abraham), the Father of the Jews. God promised Abram that He would make him a great nation. He would "bless those" who blessed him and "curse those" who cursed him and in him "all the families of the earth shall be blessed." In Genesis 17:7 God tells Abram that, "I will establish my covenant between Me and you and

your descendants ... for an everlasting covenant."

Regardless of Israel's flirtation with idolatry and their rejection of their Savior, God's covenant with Israel was always unilateral, meaning this was based on God's grace, not Israel's obedience.

When John penned "The Revelation," he dedicated over 70% of this letter to an era of time known as "Jacob's Troubles" or, more commonly, the Great Tribulation. Even though some twenty-five years earlier, Rome destroyed Jerusalem and killed any Jew they could find, John foresaw that the nation of Israel would be the center of world events in the last days. Amazingly, 1,878 years after its fall, Israel would once again appear on a world map. No statistician would have even contemplated the probabilities, unless of course, they recognized the uniqueness of the Bible. Why is Israel here? The answer is simple, God has made an everlasting covenant with Israel, promised to Abram. Jesus' establishment of His church has not nullified God's covenant to Israel, it has simply delayed.
