False Narrative



Truth is typically the first casualty in any shifting of political power. Those institutions in which we have placed our confidence suddenly become part of a propaganda network where half-truths fill news stories. A major apparatus in propaganda is the use of a false narrative.

The false narrative is an accepted premise (but not a true one). It is a crack in the armor of trust that allows the adversary to deconstruct your opinion of someone or something and at the same time, replace it with their own conclusion.

The false narrative is not some modern creation developed by marketing experts or academics in human psychology. It's been around since Genesis 3 and was perfected by Satan. Adam and Eve knew God. He provided them Eden, the most perfect place in the universe. He introduced them to each other and married them. They saw God as very, very good; however, they were never challenged to choose between His Nature and something else.

Today, every thought and action is a challenge between God and the world and every decision we make is premised on our commitment to the

Character of God. The Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil was advertised to provide us with the ability to be equal with God. In reality, we became like God having a knowledge of evil, but unlike God, evil became an intricate part of our nature.

Adam and Eve could have called on God that very moment and asked Him to respond to Satan's charge that God was limiting them. If they had done that, Genesis 3 – Revelation 22 would not have been needed. Rather, that's not what happened; they chose to accept falsehood from the father of all lies rather than wisdom from the God of all truth.

Today, we have the Bible, God's Word, but we need to use it with precision. When confronted by Satan, Eve misquoted God's directive. When we are told to "Study to show thyself approved" (2 Tim. 2:15), "study" means to "endeavor, giving diligence." We must diligently prepare to identify the false narrative so that we are equipped to confront it.

The world has formulated an entire belief system based on false narratives regarding God, sin, man, redemption, and eternity. Only those who are awakened by the Holy Spirit by the grace of God can ever penetrate those lies.
